UNIFORMS—RETIRED OFFICERS

The following is a summary of Section 438 of the Criminal Code of Canada.

“Every person shall be liable on summary conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$300.00 or to imprisonment for any term not exceeding 12 months, or to both fine or imprisonment, who without lawful authority wears any uniform of His Majesty's Naval, Land or Air Forces, or any uniform which is so similar to the uniforms of the said forces as to be likely to be mistaken therefor. Such a recourse could be enforced only before the Civil Courts.”
