## A Brief Outline of Heraldry

True Heraldry – as distinct from the tribal emblems and insignia used by warriors in ancient times – began in the second quarter of the 12th century, when it appeared almost simultaneously in several countries of Western Europe. The earliest known decorated shield was that which Henry 1 gave to his son-in-law Geoffrey of Anjou when he knighted him in 1127.

So well developed had heraldry become by the 13th century that Heralds were appointed and it was their task to set forth and document all arms in existence, to insure that duplication did not occur. Blazon or Blason – an heraldic term which originated in the custom of blowing a trumpet to announce the arrival of a knight at the joust or tournament. The blast was answered by the heralds, who described aloud and explained the arms borne by the knight.

Thus the Blazon is a concise and complete verbal description of a coat of arms according to a set of rules laid down by Gerard Legh in the 16th century and which have not been improved upon to date. Everything that occurs, the charges, divisions and colours are all recorded therein in a strict order.

Thus, firstly the arms are recorded, indicating the shield colour and the ordinaires and charges with their colours. Next appears a description of the crest, followed by a motto with translation.

**THE ARMS (shield) is of the highest importance and is often confused with the crest.**

**THE CREST is a device created and worn on the helmet and is always displayed in that position.**

**THE MOTTO generally evolved from the watchword or war cry of the family.**

In ancient times crests and mottoes may have been used by all, but with the passing of the centuries, some have been omitted or forgotten and no records of these have survived.

### THE PARKHILL FAMILY

The origin of the PARKHILL FAMILY has been traced back to the early 1500's and the information in the following three paragraphs give an insight into the Parkhill origin and this was forwarded to George Edwin Parkhill about 1931 from Mr. Forbes Parkhill, Denver, Colorado, who was born in 1892.

Two sons of the original Parkhills lived for a time in Scotland. They served as field officers under William III, Prince of Orange. For allantry in action at the Battle of the Boyne they were awarded lands in County Derry and County Antrim, Ireland. Both married Scottish wives. One of these brothers had seven and possibly eight children. Four sons and possibly one daughter migrated to United States. One son died in childhood and a son and a daughter remained in Ireland.

(William III, Prince of Orange lived 1533 to 1584)

About 1640 a ship, supposedly French, was wrecked in the English Channel. The only survivor was a child, too young to talk. He was adopted by a resident of Torquay, and named PARKHILL, after the estate of his foster father. Grown to manhood, he lived in Faversham, Kent, where he married an English woman. He is known to have had two sons who founded the Parkhill line of Glasgow and Paisley, Scotland.

On March 21, 1803 Captain David Parkhill registered the following family arms at the Court of the Lord Lyon, His Majesty's Register House, Edinburgh: Quarterly 1st and 4th argent, a stag trippant on a hillock proper, attired and unguled, Gules, within a verdure asure: 2d and 3d Gules, an escutcheon ermine between three pikes heads carped or in chief a mullet argent. Crest a cornucopia or, filled with fruit and grain proper. Motto: Capta Majora.

The second and third quarters of the above arms indicate a connection by marriage with the Geddes family. Details of the arms indicate Capt. Parkhill was a third son. Parkhills of Scotland are found in the vicinity of Glasgow and Paisley. The motto is the same as that on the arms of the Geddes Family.

The known descendents of the PARKHILL FAMILY are as follows:

Martha Parkhill lived in Ireland and Married J. Chesnut.

Hugh Parkhill was born in 1804 and died in 1868. He was a bachelor and lived in Liscolman, Ireland.

James M. Parkhill married a Miss Scott. She died leaving an infant daughter which was taken by Nancy Scott to Ireland. A son James was in New York.

John B. Parkhill was born in 1803 and died in 1887 at Cooley Pond, Brant County, Ontario. He married Mary Cochrane, who was born in 1822 and died 1897. They came in 1848 from Ireland bringing James, William and infant daughter Mary Jane. They were on the ocean six weeks and came by row boat from Niagara Falls to Brantford. They cleared the bush on the Parkhill farm at Cooley Pond and built a log house just east of where the white brick house now stands. They had seven sons and one daughter. The rest of the tree is from this family.

Margaret Parkhill married J. McCloy of New York and they had no family.

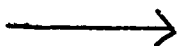
